Home Access Center (HAC)

HAC, or Home Access Center, is an online tool designed for parents /guardians to access the most current information regarding their students' progress, sign up for student/ teacher conferences, grades, and fees. It is important that you set up your account today if you have not already done so.

How to set up an account:

To create an account you must have a current and valid e-mail address on file with your school.

1. Supply a valid e-mail address to your school (if you haven't done so already).
2. Set up an ID. The Home Access Center (HAC) can be found on www.d303.org in the "For Parents" menu.
VERY IMPORTANT- City name must be entered according to the posted instructions.
