READISTEP TESTING:

This year the District has replaced our annual EXPLORE test with a ReadiStep assessment. The ReadiStep test will be given to 8th graders on October 15th. ReadiStep is a standardized achievement test designed to help students assess their readiness for high school. In addition, these test results will help your student and his or her counselor develop a high school course plan that prepares them to achieve their post-high school goals. After the testing is completed and scored, parents will receive an individualized report on each child's performance.
