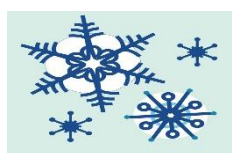
Future Saints Night at East High School


